ORDER

This Suo Motu case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu W.P.(Crl.)No.618 of 2025.

2. The case was registered for the alleged offence under Section 324, 326 r/w34 of IPC and Section 27(i) of Arms Act, 1959. The allegation against the accused was found to be in possession of knife and assaulted the complainant and his son. As such the case is pending from the year 2009. Defacto complainant is not traceable. Warrant is pending against the accused.

3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.
