ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.829 of 2013 for the alleged offence under Sections 279 and 304(A) of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

3. It is reported that in this case, the defacto complainant is not present in the given addresss and has not filed any claim petition. It is submitted that the case is presently pending at the stage of warrant and there is no previous

or subsequent case against the accused.

Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

5. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.175/2014 of District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Thirukalukundram Taluk, Chengalpattu shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of. It is made clear that disposal of this case will not, in any manner, affect the right to file a claim petition.
