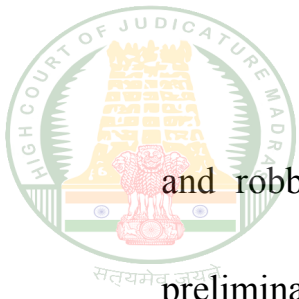
ORDER

WEB COPY The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.08.2025 for the alleged offence under Sections 126(2), 296(b), 311, 351(3) of BNS Act, in crime No.238 of 2025, on the file of respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner way laid the defacto complainant and robbed a sum of Rs.500 at knife point. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner has been suffering incarceration from 04.08.2025. He also submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner way laid the defacto complainant



and robbed a sum of Rs.500 at knife point. The investigation is also at preliminary stage. He further submitted that the petitioner is having 21 previous case pending against him. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking note to the gravity of offence, the investigation is at initial stage, and on considering the bad antecedents, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.

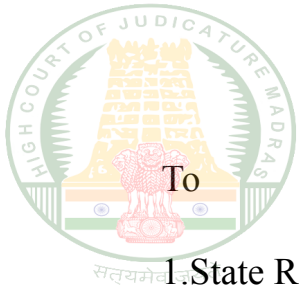
