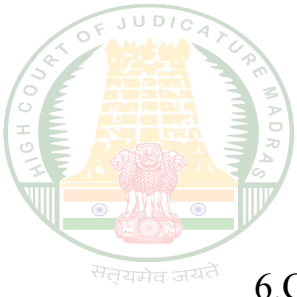
2.Mr.D.Ravichander, learned Special Government Pleader, takes notice
