WEB COPY 2. This Court, by an order dated 21.08.2025 in Crl.O.P.No.23226 of 2025 dismissed the earlier anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioners.

3. Though the learned counsel for the petitioners claimed that co-accused were already arrested and subsequently released on bail. Hence, he prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. This Court is of the view that there is no change in circumstances and since earlier anticipatory bail application was dismissed, on the ground that custodial interrogation of the petitioners are necessary in this case and illicit arrack was in possession of the petitioners herein, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
