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ORDER

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 21.07.2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 310(4) of BNS r/w Section 25(1)(a) of Arms Act in Crime No.255 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent police, seek bail. The earlier bail application of the petitioners was dismissed by this Court, vide order dated 03.09.2025 in Crl.O.P.No.24222 of 2025.

2. The case of the prosecution is that based on a secret information, the respondent police went to the spot and found that the petitioners were in possession of dangerous weapons and were preparing to commit dacoity. Hence, this case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were falsely implicated in this case, only to harass them and the petitioners are ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court and sought for bail to the petitioners.



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4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent while opposing the bail to the petitioners, reiterated the prosecution case and states that the first petitioner has 5 previous cases, the second petitioner has 13 previous cases and the third petitioner has 7 previous cases; and that the investigation is pending.

5. Considering the facts, gravity of offence, the previous antecedents of the petitioners, there is no change of circumstances after dismissal of the earlier bail application of the petitioners in Crl.O.P.No.24222 of 2025 and the fact that investigation is pending, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
