ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.This case in Cr.No.600 of 2013 dated 23.07.2013 was registered for the alleged offences under Sections 392 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. The stolen property has been recovered and returned to the defacto complainant. The defacto complainant does not want to pursue the case any further. The case is pending at evidence stage.

3.Considering the nature of allegation, the antecedents of the accused, it is evident that even if the accused is continuing to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.
