Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 and the learned counsel appearing for the Respondents 4 and 5 and perused the materials available on record.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and also considering that the present Writ Petition is filed seeking simple writ of mandamus, this Court directs the respondents 1 to 3 to consider petitioner's representation dated 19.11.2024, conduct enquiry after issuing notice to the petitioners as well as the private respondents and pass orders in accordance with law.

4. With the abovesaid direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
