ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
18.08.2025 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 296(b),
140(2), 308(3) and 351(3) of BNS, 2023, in Crime No.339 of 2025 on the
file of the respondent police, seeks bail.



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2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner aided Accused No.1, who was having property dispute with the de-facto complainant and on the date of occurrence, this petitioner along with other accused threatened the de-facto complainant with knife by demanding execution of documents in favour of Accused No.1. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not having any previous case. Since Accused No.1 is a History Sheeter and for the purpose of implicating this petitioner, a false complaint has been registered as if the petitioner along with other accused threatened the de-facto complainant. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that there are totally three accused in this case, the petitioner is ranked as Accused No.3 and on the instigation of Accused No.1, he threatened the de-facto complainant with knife point and also criminally intimidated him. Hence, he opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.



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5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate at Madhavaram** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] **the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks, thereafter as and when required for interrogation;**



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[c] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

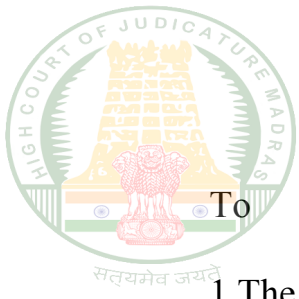
[d] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
