ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case in Cr.No.611 of 2000 dated 22.07.2000 was registered for the alleged offences under Sections 416, 419 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. It is stated that the occurrence is of the year 2000. The Accused is said to have been availed financial assistance from the defacto Complainant to the amount of Rs.5,00,000/-. A part amount has been paid by the Accused



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to the defacto Complainant. Now, the defacto complainant is not traceable and the case is pending at warrant stage.

3. Considering the nature of allegation, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, warrant could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in CC.No.3226/2001 on the file of the III Metropolitan Magistrate Court, George Town Taluk, Chennai stands quashed. This Suo Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
