2. This case in Crime No.2058 of 2016 is registered for alleged offence under Section 341, 324, 506 (ii) of IPC. The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this designated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per *Gian Singh -vs- State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303)*.

3. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.435 of 2019 on the file of Judicial Magistrate Cout No.II, Alandur Taluk, Chengalpattu is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
