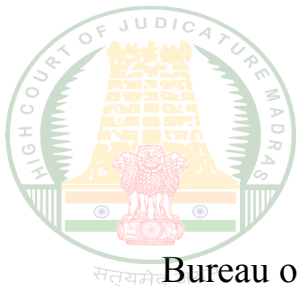

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is aged about 62 years. Hence, he finds it difficult to comply with the condition in view of his old age. Hence, prays to

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3.The learned Special Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner is complying with the conditions regularly without any deviation.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, age of the petitioner and also considering the submission made by the learned Special Public Prosecutor that the petitioner is complying with the conditions diligently, the order dated 24.11.2023 made in Crl.M.P.No.18442 of 2023 in Crl.M.P.No.124 of 2023 in Crl.A.No.12 of 2023 is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court once in six months at 10.30 a.m., on the first working day of the month, until further orders. All other conditions remain unaltered.
