ORDER

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The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 28.08.2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 126(b), 109(1),61(2),351(3) of BNS r/w 49, 3(5) of BNS (341,307,120(b), 506 109, 34 of I.P.C in Crime No.424 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that this petitioner instigated A3 to attack the defacto complainant. Accordingly the defacto complainant attacked the defacto complainant and caused severe injuries to him. Hence, this case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court and sought for bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent while opposing the bail to the petitioner, reiterated the



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prosecution case. He further submitted that the petitioner is habitual offender and there are 8 previous cases pending against him and the injured discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts, gravity of offence and the specific overt act attributed by this petitioner that he has instigated the other accused person to attack the defacto complainant and the bad antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
