PRAYER :- Criminal Revision Case filed under Sec.438 and 442 of BNSS, praying to set aside the order dated 28.08.2024 passed by the Special Court hearing cases under the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Namakkal in Criminal Appeal no. 176 of 2023, which confirmed the order, dated 10.10.2023, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, Kumarapalayam in STCA NO. 40 OF 2020

ORDER

Today, when the matter taken up for hearing, both the learned counsel for Petitioner and respondent appeared and submitted a joint compromise memo.

2. As per the terms of compromise, the petitioner has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.2,30,000/- (Rupees two lakhs thirty thousand only) as full and final settlement to the respondent. Out of the said amount, the petitioner had already deposited an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- before the trial court as per the order passed by this court in Crl.M.P.No. 17188 of 2024. The respondent is permitted to withdraw the said amount within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. The joint compromise memo is recorded.

3. In the result, this Criminal Revision Petition is disposed of as the matter was settled between the parties in terms of a joint memo of compromise. Thus, the petitioner is acquitted. The joint memo of compromise shall be forming part and parcel of this order. Consequently, the connected Criminal Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
