ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.This case in Cr.No.849 of 2017 dated 13.05.2017 was registered for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 384 and 506(2) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. The allegation is that the Accused had knife and robbed a sum of Rs.600/- from the defacto complainant. Defacto complainant is presently not traceable. Accused has been attending the proceedings regularly and there is no previous or subsequent case against the accused.

3.Considering the nature of allegation, the antecedents of the accused, it is evident that even if the accused is continuing to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.
