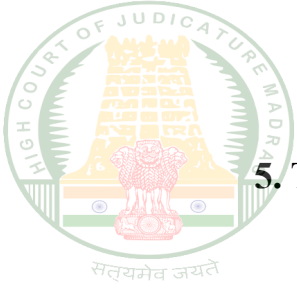


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2. Heard Mr.A.Mohan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mr.R.Neelakandan, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondents 1 to 5 and Mr.P.G.Thiyagu, learned counsel appearing for the 6th respondent.

When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of the official respondents viz., respondents 1 to 5 submitted that already the 3rd respondent has submitted a report before the Revenue Divisional Officer and the enquiry is now pending before the Revenue Divisional Officer.

In the light of the above development it is left open to the Revenue Divisional Officer to conduct enquiry by giving opportunity to the petitioner and the 6th respondent and final orders shall be passed on its own merits and in accordance with law by the 2nd respondent within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
