Developing any personal conflict either with the Police Authorities or with the Public Authorities are highly unwarranted. 3. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the party-in-

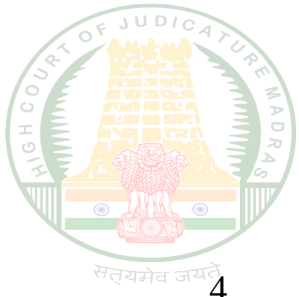
person made a submission that he will be permitted to withdraw the writ petition. He also made an endorsement in the case bundle to that effect.
