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## **ORDER**

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 12.07.2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 5(l), 5(n), r/w 6 of POCSO Act, Section 343, 376AB and 506(i) of I.P.C in Crime No.307 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the step father of the victim girl has committed aggravated penetrative sexual assault on the victim girl. Hence, the defacto complainant herself has filed the present complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that major part of the investigation in this case has been completed. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court and sought for bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent while opposing the bail to the petitioner, reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that investigation in this case is not yet



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completed and he also produced the copy of the F.I.R and the statement recorded from the victim girl.

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5. The statement recorded from the minor victim girl under section 164 of Cr.P.C reveals that the petitioner has continuously harassing her and also committed aggravated penetrative sexual assault on her

6. Considering the facts of the case and the nature of offence committed by the petitioner and investigation in this case is not yet completed, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
