ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.270 of 2001 for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324 and 307 of I.P.C. The occurrence is of the year 2001. The mother case related to this case proceeded further and resulted in an acquittal. The grounds for acquittal also apply to the present accused. This case has been pending in respect of accused A3 and A4 for execution of warrant. It is also suspected that they could have died since the death is not reported, they are not able to generate the death certificate.

3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the background of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to



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a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.
