ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. **This Case in Crime No.23 of 2022 dated 08.01.2022 is registered for alleged offences under Section 4(1)(a) of Prohibition Act.** The accused was found to be in possession of transporting liquor bottles of 2.2 litres which is less than 4.5 litres permitted limit by the Government and the case is pending in the summon stage and no other previous case.

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Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons / warrant could not be served / executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

3. Accordingly, the proceedings in **S.T.C.No.1000 of 2022 on the file. of Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Villupuram Taluk, Villupuram** is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
