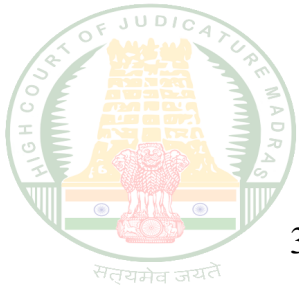

ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. In this case, either the defacto complainant or the accused has remained untraceable and as a result, the case could not proceed. The prosecution has already considered filing an application for withdrawal of prosecution before the learned Magistrate which is currently pending.



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3. Be that as it may, in view of the circumstances and even considering the request for withdrawal of prosecution, allowing the case to remain on the file of the Magistrate would serve no useful purpose.

4. Accordingly, the case in S.T.C.No. 14959 of 2019 on the file of Judicial Magistrate No.II, Coimbatore Taluk, Coimbatore shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
