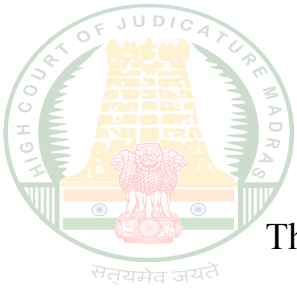

ORDER



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WEB.COM This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Special Court for the Exclusive Trial of SC and ST Cases, Dharmapuri to consider the bail application sympathetically and pass orders on merits on the same on the petitioners' surrender in connection with Cr.No.406 of 2025 pending investigation on the file of the second respondent police.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration of the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Special Court for the Exclusive Trial of SC and ST Cases, Dharmapuri, to consider the petitioners' bail application, preferably on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime No.406 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. The petitioners shall surrender before the concerned Jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands ordered.
