**ORDER**

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on **08.09.2025** for the alleged offences punishable under Sections **296(b) 115(2), 351(2), 75(2) of BNS and Sections 7 r/w 89, 92(b) Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, in Crime No.482 of 2025** on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. Earlier, the petitioner had moved a bail petition before this Court in Crl.O.P.No.25640 of 2025 and the same was dismissed by this Court on 18.09.2025 on the ground that the investigation is pending. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case, due to political influence. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police reported that the investigation is almost completed and the petitioner has no previous cases against him. Hence, he opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and the petitioner has no antecedents, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only)** with **two sureties**, for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Krishnagiri** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal

Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

**[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;**

[c] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[d] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
