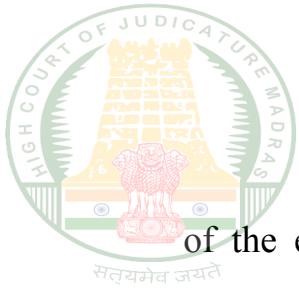

ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case arises out of matrimonial discord. The accused are tried for the offences under Sections 294(b) and 324 of Indian Penal Code, 1860. Parties have resolved the conflict and are living together.
