ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case, Cr.No.448 of 2019 is registered for alleged offences under Sections 341, 294(b), 324, 384 and 506(ii) of IPC, 1860 r/w.34 of IPC, 1860. A1 is present A2 had died and non bailable warrant is pending against A3. The defacto complainant also doesn't want to pursue the matter further.

3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons / warrant could not be served / executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.
