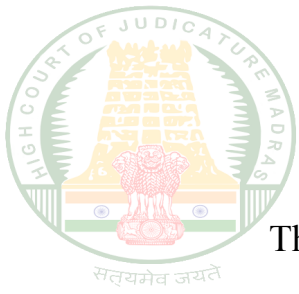

PRAYER : Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 428 of Cr.P.C., under Section 528 of BNSS, to direct the Special Court for Trial of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 Judge, Namakkal, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day of surrender in Crime No.281 of 2025 on the file of the 2nd respondent.

ORDER



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This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the Judge, Special Court for Trial of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Namakkal, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and consequently, consider his bail petition in connection with Crime No.281 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent police, on merits on the same day.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the Judge, Special Court for Trial of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Namakkal, to consider the petitioner's bail application, preferably on the same day of his surrender in connection with Crime No.281 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989.

3. The petitioner shall surrender before the Jurisdictional Court



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concerned, within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a
