When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the 1st and 2nd respondents Police, submitted that the respondents 1 and 2 have not asked the Bank/R3 to freeze the account of the petitioner. He further submitted that he understands that based on the request of the National Cybercrime Reporting Portal (NCRP), the petitioner's bank account has been frozen.
