ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.146 of 2017 for the alleged offence under Section 392 I.P.C. The occurrence is said to have taken place during the year 2017. The allegation in this case is that the accused snatched gold chain from the defacto complainant. It is submitted that the stolen chain was recovered and handed over to the defacto complainant and the defacto complainant does not want to pursue the matter any further. It is further submitted that there is no previous or subsequent case as against the accused and he has been attending the case regularly.

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3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case and the antecedents of the accused, any further continuance of case would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4.Accordingly, the case in CC.300055/2017 of JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE,ARANI, Arani Taluk, Tiruvannamalai stands quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
