ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case in C.C.No.254 of 2008 was taken on the file of the Judicial Magistrate IV, Salem Taluk, Salem, for the alleged offence under Sections 454 and 380 of I.P.C. The occurrence is said to have taken place on 11.08.2019. The accused committed theft of defacto-complainant's gold articles. It is reported that the property involved in this case has been recovered and handed over to the defacto-complainant. The defacto-complainant does not want to pursue the case any further. It is reported that as against A1 and A2 warrant is pending and as against A3 and A4 summons is



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pending.

3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed as against accused A1 and A2 and the summons could not be served on accused A3 and A4, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4.Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.254 of 2008 of Judicial Magistrate IV, Salem Taluk, Salem, stands quashed. This Suo Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
