**ORDER**

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case, Cr.No.70 of 2016 was registered for the alleged offence under Sections 379 and 430 of IPC. The occurrence is of the year 2016. The allegation in this case is that the accused had stolen two units of river sand. There are no previous or subsequent cases against the accused.

3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summon could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial.
