ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.731 of 2020 dated 31.12.2020 for the alleged offence under Section 4(1)(k) of The Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, 1937. The allegation in this case is that the accused, the owner of a petty shop, had permitted a person to consume liquor in front of his shop premises without any Government License. It is reported that the case is presently pending at the stage of summons. There is no previous or subsequent case as against the accused.

3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in S.T.C.No. 406 of 2021 on the file of District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Neyveli Taluk, Cuddalore shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
