In view of the same, this Court, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, is inclined to direct the 2nd respondent to consider the application of the petitioner in Application No. TN-720240622605 dated 22.06.2024 and pass final orders on its' own merits within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. With the above directions, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
