ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.47 of 2019 dated 18.02.2019 for the alleged offence under Section 4(1)(a) of The Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, 1937. The allegation in this case is that the accused possessed 15 liters of illicit arrack and seven liquor bottles of 180 ml each without valid Government licence. It is reported that the case is presently pending at the stage of summons. There is no previous or subsequent case as against the accused.

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3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in S.T.C.No. 269 of 2019 on the file of District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Kurinjipadi Taluk, Cuddalore shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
