ORDER

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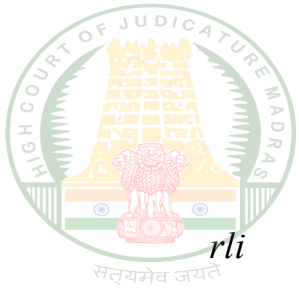

No.5399 of 2024 to move an appropriate application seeking visitation rights, setting out the present circumstances.
