2. Mrs.R.Sreevidhya, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the 3rd respondent and Mr.K.Vinod, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the 4th and 5th respondents.

3. Though notice was served and the names of the 1st and 2nd respondents were printed in the cause list, none appeared on their behalf.

4. Heard learned counsel on either side.

5. Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, this Court is inclined to order this petition.

6. Accordingly this petition is allowed. Registry is directed to number the appeal, if it is otherwise in order and post the matter for admission.

7. It is underscored that in the eventuality of the appellant succeeding in the appeals to be taken on record, he would not be entitled to interest for default period.
