ORDER



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The petitioners, who apprehend arrest for the alleged offence under Sections 85 of BNS (498-A of IPC) in Cr.No.26 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police seeks anticipatory bail.

When the matter is called today, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) reported that now, the respondent police has conducted investigation and altered the offences from Section 85 BNS to Section 85 BNS and Section 3(1)(s) of SC/ST(POA) Act 1989.
