ORDER

This matter has been listed today under the caption “for reporting compliance”.

Based on the Affidavit of Undertaking dated 18.02.2025 filed by the petitioner agreeing to pay the entire amount along with interest to the respondent in two instalments, this Court had disposed of the present Revision Petition directing the petitioner to maintain sufficient funds in the bank account to honour the cheques which have been handed over by him to the respondent and directed to list the matter today for reporting compliance.
