COMMON ORDER

These Sua Motu cases are dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.)No.618 of 2025.

These are cases in counter. These cases in Cr.Nos.315 and 314 of 2022 are registered for alleged offence(s) under Section 294(b), 324 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002 and Section 294(b), 323, 355, 506(ii) and 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 respectively. The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this designated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with.
