This civil miscellaneous petition has been filed to condone the delay of 31 days in filing the above civil miscellaneous appeal.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that R3 & R8 are not the main contesting respondents, therefore they want to give up the said respondents from the array of parties. The said submission is recorded. Accordingly, they are removed from the array of parties. With regard to R1, R2, R6 & R7, learned counsel filed vakalat and represented the respective respondents. With regard to R4 & R5, though notice had been served, none appeared before this Court.
