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COMMON ORDER

Though these Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petitions are listed for final hearing on 06.06.2025, there was no representation for the respondent. In order to give one more opportunity to the respondent to put forth her objections to the transfer sought for, the Registry was directed to list these cases today. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the respondent.

2. I proceeded to hear Ms.Abinumonisha, learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner is the husband in a matrimonial proceedings and he has sought for the transfer of above three proceedings from the Courts of Madurai to the Courts in Chennai. It is seen from the averments set out in the affidavit filed in support of the transfer petitions that the respondent has already shifted her residence and presently residing in Chennai where she is employed. There shall be no order as to costs. Connected Civil Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
