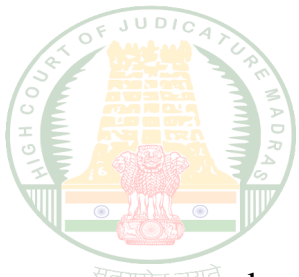

PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pass orders on the representation/objection submitted by the petitioner dated 21.07.2025 served on the second respondent through Registered Post with Acknowledgment due on 25.07.2025 against the promotion of fourth respondent made in the proceedings of

5. This Writ Petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.
