ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case in Cr.No.535 of 2017 is registered for alleged offences under Section 454 and 380 of IPC. The incident occurred during the year 2017. The allegation in this case is that the accused stolen gold coin belonging to the defacto complainant. It is submitted that the stolen property was recovered and handed over to its owner. It is further submitted that the defacto complainant does not want to pursue the matter any further. It is reported that there is no previous or subsequent case as against the accused and presently, the case is pending at the warrant stage.

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3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the proceedings in CC.400067 of 2018 of Judicial Magistrate No.1, Bhavani Taluk, Erode is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
