ORDER

The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that as against the order passed in the Writ Petition, a Writ Appeal has been preferred in W.A.No.3337 of 2024 and the same is pending for more than one year.

2.In view of the aforesaid submission, I am of the view that since the Hon'ble Division Bench has taken cognizance of the matter, it would not be appropriate to parallely adjudicate this Contempt Petition.
