ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody
on 16.06.2025, for the offence punishable under Sections 307, 308 and 511
of IPC in Crime No.94 of 2001, registered on the file of the respondent,
seeks bail.



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2. This Court dismissed the petitioner's earlier bail petition on the ground that the committal proceedings are yet to be commenced and further observed that once the case is committed to Sessions Court, it will be open to the petitioner to renew the petition for bail. In this case, A2 died and the case is pending against the petitioner alone and the case is already committed.

3. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Subordinate Judge, Alandur** and on further conditions that:



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[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the trial Court on all working day at 10.30.a.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly cause any threat to the de facto complainant and witnesses;

[e] the petitioner to give an undertaking that if required for being identified by witnesses during investigation or for police custody beyond the first fifteen days, he shall comply to the directions as may be given by the Court in this regard;

[f] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in



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accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
