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ORDER

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The petitioner herein apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 403 of IPC and Section 66D of IT Act in Crime No.19 of 2025, on the file of the respondent Police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. This Court earlier considered the arguments advanced before me in detail and dismissed the bail application of the petitioner by citing the following reasons:

It is also seen that in this case, the fulcrum is A1 and his son A2. A2 not only received the money of the victims but also conducted regular zoom meetings, canvassed to the victims giving high projection and also posted web sheets and XLR sheets with false particulars, which turned to be fabricated. In this case, the defacto complainant was cheated to the tune of Rs.22,48,500/-. If A1 & A2 are granted relief of bail, it would be difficult to recover the misappropriated amount and identify others involvement. Added to it, A1 had two previous cases of similar in nature in Crime No.s22 & 52 of 2025 and A2 has one previous case in Crime No.22 of 2025.



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Now, without any change in circumstances, the present petition is filed. Hence, this Court is not inclined to reconsider the anticipatory bail petitions since, it was earlier elaborately considered.

3. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
