2. Heard Mr.Dinesh Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr.C.Jayaprakash, learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of



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respondents 1 to 3 and Mr.K.Karthikeyan, learned Government Advocate appearing for the fourth respondent.

When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 to 3 and learned Government Advocate appearing for the fourth respondent submitted that, already orders have been passed by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Mayiladuthurai, through proceedings dated 19.09.2025, rejecting the claim made by the petitioners. A copy of the order was also placed before this Court.

4. In the light of the above development, no further orders can be passed by this Court in this writ petition. If the petitioners are aggrieved, it is left open to the petitioners to work out their remedy in the manner known to law.

5. This writ petition is accordingly disposed of. No costs.
