Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents, particularly the 2nd respondent to extend the period of Muthawalliship of the petitioner in respect of Madharasathul Kamariya Wakf, Keeranur Village, Palani Taluk, Dindigul District, vide G.S.No.272/MDU, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 06.10.2025.

ORDER



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Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.M.Fakkir Mohideen, the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondents / Wakf Board. With the consent of the counsel on either side, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal.

2.The petitioner was appointed as hereditary Muthawalli of Madarasathul Kamariya Wakf, Keeranur Village, Palani Taluk, Dindigul District. His term was subsequently extended for a period of three years from 26.10.2022 to 25.10.2025. Even before 25.10.2025, the petitioner has submitted representations on 15.05.2025 and 06.10.2025, seeking extension. However, there has been no response to the said representations given by the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner has been constrained to file the present Writ Petition.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the respondents would submit that the delay is only on account of the Board not being constituted and it is functioning with the presence of C.E.O. who is burdened with additional duties. However, the learned counsel submits that the petitioner's



representation would be considered on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve (12) weeks.

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4.Considering the above, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner's representations dated 15.05.2025 and 06.10.2025 on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
