ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 18.09.2025, for the alleged offence punishable under Section 303(2) of BNS in Crime No.393 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is that he joined hands with other accused stolen the gold jewels worth about 2.5 crores from the bus in which the defacto complainant has travelled.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that both the accused were arrested and entire property were also recovered and the petitioner is in custody from 18.09.205. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police reported that entire properties were recovered and the petitioner is in custody from 18.09.2025 and he is not having any previous case. Hence, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6. Considering the fact that entire property were recovered and the petitioner is not having any previous case and considering the period of incarceration, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.



7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the *learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankagiri, Salem.*, and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself, as laid down by the Hon'ble
