Prayer : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and pass orders on the petitioner's representation dated 26.03.2025 and to pay the Petitioner his five (5) years retained benefits under the Voluntary Retirement Scheme - 2000 (VRS2000) in terms of Annexure-I, Clauses 5 and 6, together with all benefits admissible under Regulation 15(1) of the Indian Overseas Bank Officers' Service Regulations (OSR) as claimed in the Petitioner's VRS2000 application dated 15.12.2000 within a stipulated time to the petitioner considering the petitioner's age of 75 years.
