ORDER

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent
police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(3) TNG Act, r/w 318(4)

of the BNS, 2023 in Crime No. 276 of 2025, on the file of the respondent

Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

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2. The allegation against the petitioners is that on 10.10.2025, the petitioners and others collected Rs.7/- from the de-facto complainant and the public under the guise of “High Returns”. After receiving money, the petitioners had cheated the de-facto complainant and the public. Hence the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submits that the petitioners are ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court and ready to furnish sufficient solvent sureties for their release. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) for the respondent police, reiterated the prosecution case and submits that the



investigation is completed. He further submits that the petitioners have no previous case. However, he opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5. Heard the learned counsels and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the fact the petitioners have no previous case; that the investigation is completed in this case; that the co-accused were granted bail in CrI.M.P.No.13437 of 2025, dated 14.10.2025 on the file of Judicial Magistrate No.I, Vellore; this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.I, Vellore**, on condition that the petitioners shall
